Changes in response to Covid-19 Conditions

June 13, 2020

In accordance to Maine's current "Keep Maine Healthy" Executive mandate, guests who are not Maine, Vermont or New Hampshire residents or essential workers are required to complete the State's Certificate of Compliance prior to check-in.

To protect our guests and employees we have made these adjustments:

-We are reducing interactions at the front desk by taking reservations/payments online or by phone as much as possible. State law requires wearing face masks inside the lobby.

-We are following up-to-date CDC recommendations for our housekeeping operations, using an EPA approved disinfectant for COVID-19.

-We are suspending daily housekeeping during a guest's stay of three nights or less.

Service changes to reduce contact/promote distancing:

-Fresh towels, linens and amenities are available by calling 207-338-2353

-Clean phones, ice buckets, notepads, pens are available by request.

-Trash may be disposed of in the receptacle outside the lobby.

-Please remember to take your key when you leave your room, rooms lock automatically when you close the door.

We ask guests and all staff to follow CDC recommendations regarding social distancing (remaining at least 6 feet away) and to use face masks when distancing is not possible. We ask anyone who is unwell to stay at home.
